I hope you and your family are able to spend a few minutes today enjoying the beautiful weather. Before we head into the weekend, I want to share a few announcements and resources.




### Stay Home, Stop the Spread Order

Earlier today, a [Stay Home, Stop the Spread order](#) was issued by County Judge Mark Keough. The order is effective tonight at 11:59 p.m. through Sunday, April 12. Yesterday, Conroe ISD made the decision to move to essential operations starting on Monday, March 30. This decision is in alignment with today's order from Judge Keough. Each of these actions is designed to slow the spread of COVID-19. This order does not impact our meal distribution or systems to support distance learning. However, when picking up meals or instructional items, social distancing is imperative.



### Free Meals

Conroe ISD will continue distributing meals to students on Tuesday, March 31, and Thursday, April 2, from 10 AM - 1 PM. Students do not have to be present to receive the meals. Curbside distribution will continue to be at Austin Elementary, Caney Creek High School, Conroe High School, Grand Oaks High School, Hauke High School, Knox Junior High, Oak Ridge High School, The Woodlands College Park High School, The Woodlands High School, and Washington Junior High. To promote social distancing, meals will be placed in the trunks of vehicles if an interior trunk release is available.
