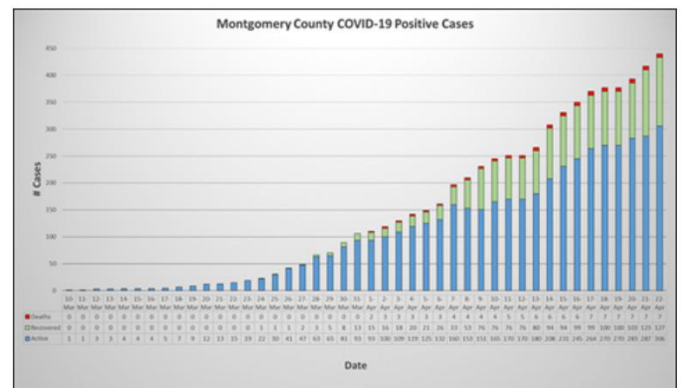
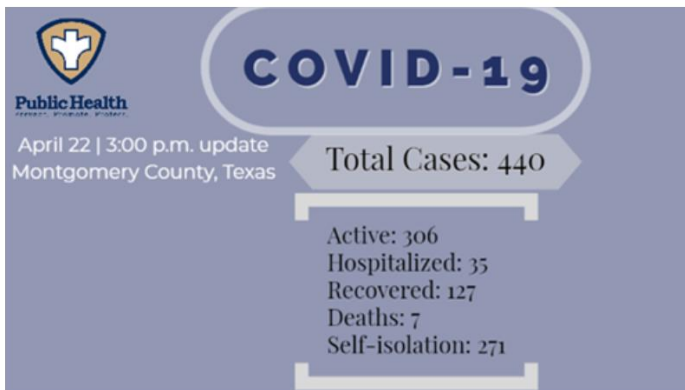
Status Update from the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm there are now 440 total positive cases of COVID-19, up 23 cases from yesterday. The statewide stay-at-home order is still in effect.
