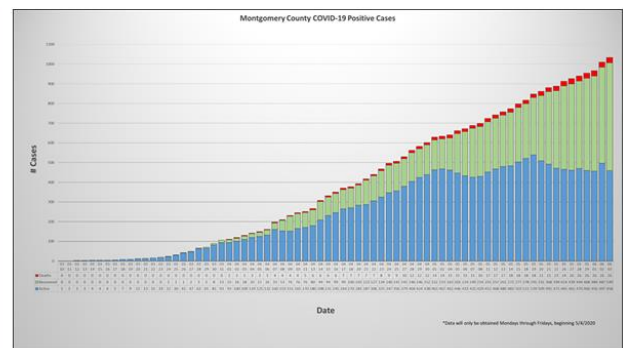
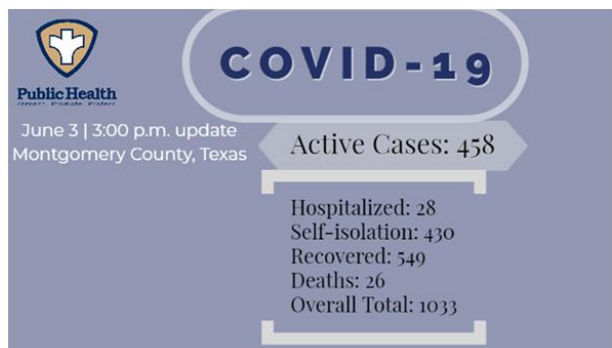

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm the number of ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 has decreased to 458 today. That number includes 28 hospitalizations. 549 people have fully recovered. The number of total positive cases has increased 23 since yesterday to 1,033.

One of our partners in the voucher program, America's ER, will move its drive-thru testing site beginning Friday to its standing ER location on FM 2978 at Research Forest in Magnolia. Starting Friday, you must make an appointment at this site before obtaining a test. For the remainder of Wednesday and Thursday, you can still obtain a test at WoodsEdge Church after calling the Call Center to obtain a voucher. For more information, call 936-523-5040.
