Testing will be held by reservation only in The Pavilion Lounge, located inside the Event Center. Visitors can park in the Gold Lot next to the venue and parking garage which is accessible from Six Pines drive.

With an accuracy rate of 98%, Genalyte’s serology test minimizes false-positive and false negative rates. All samples are processed in Genalyte’s Austin facility.

Genalyte's antibody testing service is meant for people who are no longer experiencing any symptoms and have been symptom-free for at least 14 days. Once a blood sample is drawn, it will be sent to the lab for processing, and results will be available to participants within 24-48 hours.
