Daily COVID-19 Update for Montgomery County

Status Update from the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with the Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, can confirm an additional death related to COVID-19.

A woman in her 60s, from Conroe, died in the hospital. She had co-morbidities in addition to testing positive for COVID-19.

We can also confirm:

- TOTAL cases of COVID-19 increased by 162 to 15,920 since yesterday's (11/19) report. All 162 new cases were tested in the month of November.
- ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 decreased by 14 to 2,292 since yesterday's (11/19) report.
- 25 residents are known, as a result of contact investigations, to be in the hospital. Contact investigations have not been initiated on all reported cases.
- 10,274 people have clinically recovered.

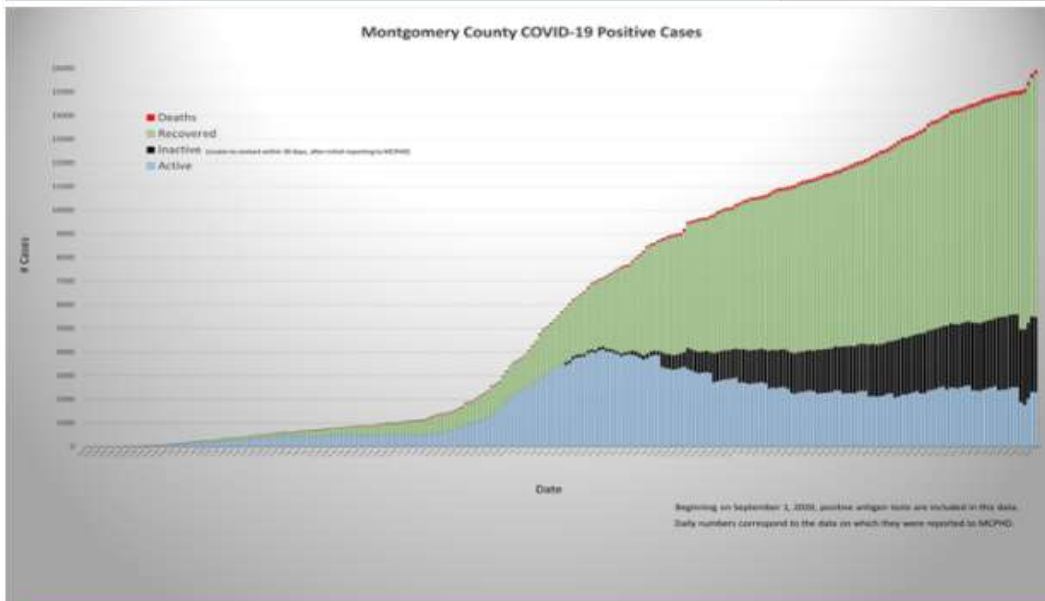
