THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (January 22, 2021) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors held its regular meeting via videoconference on Thursday, January 21, 2021 at 6 p.m.

The Board of Directors took the following actions on the Consent Agenda:

- Received Administrative Reports from Township departments.
- Approved Resolution No. 001-21 supporting the submittal of a bid to host the 2024 Texas Recreation and Parks Society (TRAPS) Annual Institute.
- Approved Resolution No. 002-21 for Adoption of Prevailing Wage Rate Scale for Construction Projects.
- Approved an extension of the Professional Engineering Services Agreement with Moffatt and Nichol.
- Approved an Interlocal Agreement for Law Enforcement Services with Harris County.
- Approved a Storm Sewer and Drainage Easement with MUD No. 1 for a portion of Restricted Reserve “I” of Village of Panther Creek Section 14.

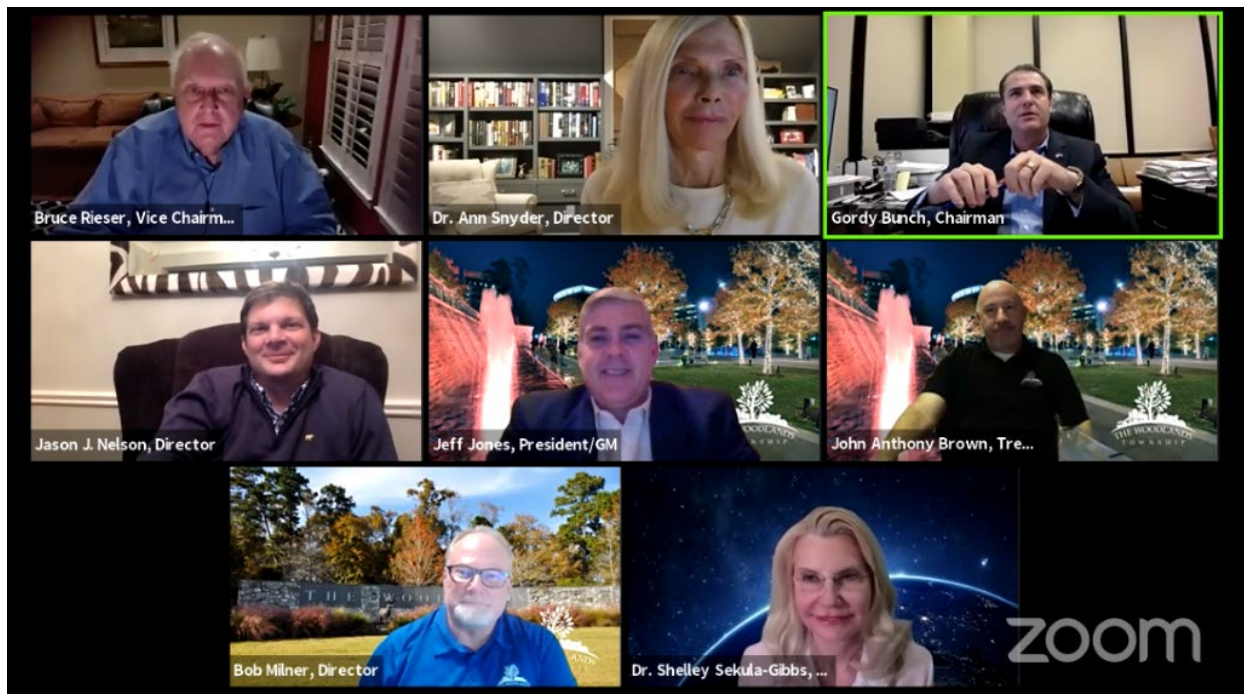


Director Dr. Ann K. Snyder provided an update on non-profits including Interfaith of The Woodlands and Montgomery County Food Bank.
