## **Daily COVID-19 Update for Montgomery County**

*Status Update from the Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management*

MONTGOMERY COUNTY – Montgomery County Public Health District, in conjunction with the Montgomery County Office of Homeland Security and Emergency Management, would like to announce a change in COVID-19 reporting moving forward.

With steadily decreasing cases and increased vaccinations, MCPHD will begin scaling back COVID-19 updates. **Starting the first week of June, MCPHD will release COVID-19 updates on a weekly basis – Wednesdays only.** In the case of a future surge in cases, we will re-evaluate the need for increased reporting at that time.

The final day to receive a vaccine at Woodforest Stadium is Tuesday, June 1<sup>st</sup>. You can make an appointment through MCPHD for that day here: [mcphd-tx.org](http://mcphd-tx.org). If you have questions, please call the COVID-19 Call Center at 936-523-3916. It is open Monday-Thursday from 8:00am – 4:30pm and Friday from 8:00am – 4:00pm. **\*Please note, the vaccine site at Woodforest Stadium, the COVID-19 Call Center and the offices of MCPHD will be closed on Monday, May 31<sup>st</sup> in observance of Memorial Day.**

Today, we can confirm:


- TOTAL cases of COVID-19 increased by 17 to 54,376 since Thursday's (5/27) report.
- ACTIVE cases of COVID-19 decreased by 178 to 1,058 since Thursday's (5/27) report. On Tuesdays and Fridays, we account for additional inactive cases who we have been unable to contact for 30 days or more. Today, we added 145 inactive cases. *(Starting next week with new weekly reporting, we will account for inactive cases on Wednesdays.)*
- 61 county residents are known, as a result of contact investigations, to be in the hospital. Contact investigations have not been initiated on all reported cases.

- 28,933 people have clinically recovered.

**The Testing Positivity Rate for Montgomery County is 5%, down from 6% last week. This number is updated weekly on Wednesdays.**

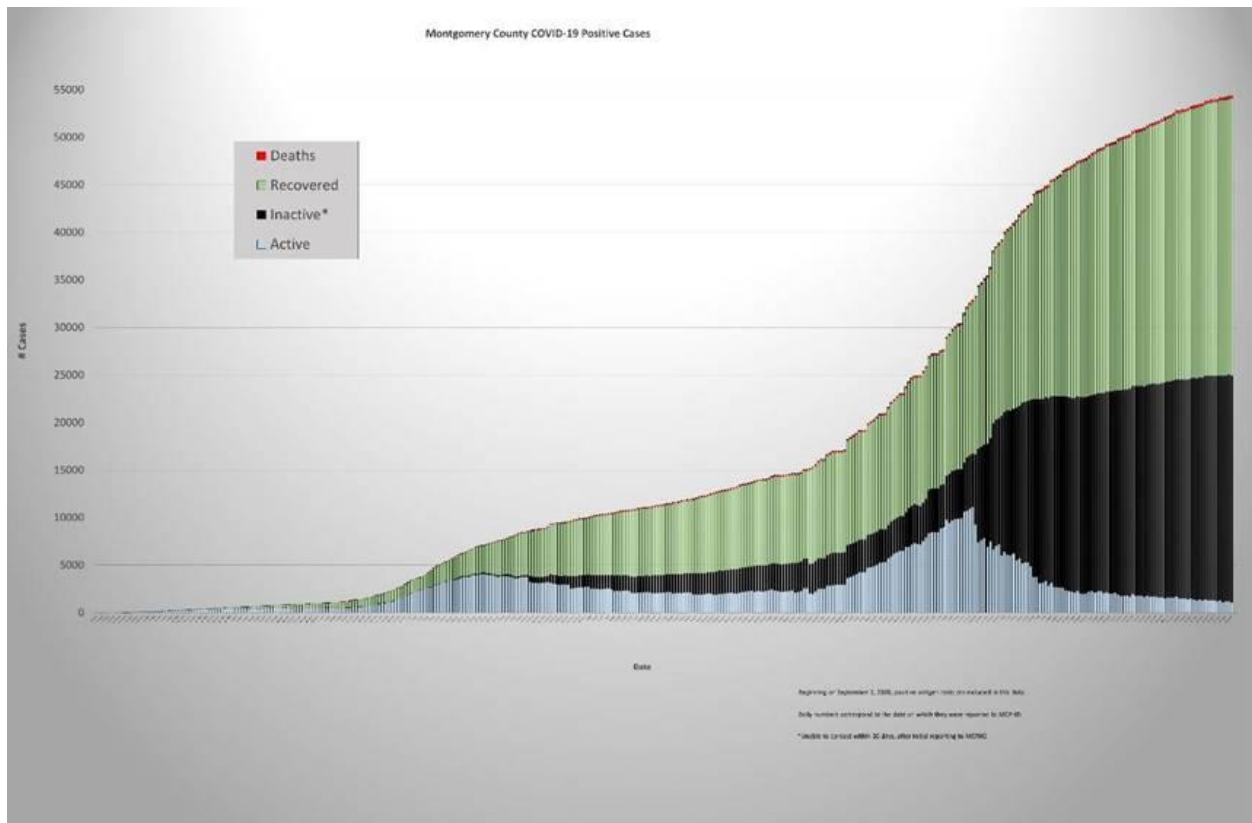
