THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (August 16, 2021) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors kicked off its 2022 Budget Workshops on Monday, August 16, 2021 at The Woodlands Township Town Hall, 2801 Technology Forest Boulevard in The Woodlands, Texas.

The Board of Directors took the following actions on the Regular Agenda:

- Received the 2021/2022 Anticipated Debt Service Collection Rate and the 2021 Excess Debt Service Tax Collections Report, as certified by the Montgomery County Tax Assessor/Collector;
- Received a report regarding the 2021 no-new-revenue tax rate and voter-approval tax rate;
- Received the 2022 Preliminary Budget for The Woodlands Township;
- Received Budget initiatives related to the 2022 Preliminary Budget and Five-Year Plan;
- Took no action on the proposed 2021 debt service tax rate and maintenance and operations tax rate;
- Took no action on the date and time for a public hearing on the proposed 2021 property tax rate;
- Awarded bid for streetscape maintenance services;
