The Woodlands Township holds Board meeting

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (June 27, 2013) – The Woodlands Township Board of Directors held its second Board meeting of the month on Wednesday, June 26, 2013, at The Woodlands Township Town Hall, at 6 p.m., and made determination on the following agenda items:

- Approved the financial report;
- Read a proclamation to honor the Class 5A State Baseball Champion Highlanders of The Woodlands High School;
- Received the 2013 Memorial Hermann Ironman Texas wrap up;
- Received an update from San Jacinto River Authority regarding the construction plans and schedule in association with the Groundwater Reduction Plan project;
- Received an update regarding an enhanced communication plan related to traffic impacts in The Woodlands as a result of the San Jacinto River Authority construction plans associated with the Groundwater Reduction Plan project;
- Approved a recommendation from the Audit Committee regarding acceptance of the 2012 Comprehensive Annual Financial Report;
- Received a follow-up presentation from White Oak Studio regarding the Shadowbend Park Renovation Plans and approved \$1.3 million in renovations to the pool and park, subject to 2014 Budget approval and construction documents;
- Tabled an award of bid for playground equipment;
- Received an update from the Ad Hoc Economic Development Committee;
- Received a status report regarding The Woodlands Township's Request for Proposal for the provision of insurance and risk management services;
- Discussed the 2013 Budget Workshop schedule.

Whereas, it has been an incredible journey in 2013 for The Woodlands Highlanders Baseball Team; and

Whereas, in March, the Highlanders attended the National High School Invitational in Cary, N.C., as one of the 16 top high school teams in the United States, and the only team invited from Texas; and

Whereas, they went into – the NHSI ranked #1 in the U.S.A.; and

Whereas, they went 11-1 in district AND were the District 14-5A Champions; and

Whereas, the Highlanders went into the playoffs ranked 4th in the country and #1 in Texas; and

Whereas, the Highlanders produced these results in the playoffs:

Round 1 (May 2-3) – swept Atascosita in 3 game series (8-2;6-0)

Round 2 (May 10) – went to Austin and where the three game series cut to 1 game due to weather against Stoney Point(Austin) - TWHS 2 – Stoney Point 1

Round 3 (May 16-17) – swept Round Rock in 3 game series (4-0;8-2)

Round 4 (May 24-25) – swept Plano West in 3 game series (8-1;8-0); and

Whereas, at the regional finals at Disch Falk Field at UT it was a hard fought battle against Rockwall with The Woodlands winning the series two games to one; and

Whereas, the Highlanders defeated San Antonio Northside O'Connor in the State Semifinals, 2-1; and

Whereas, the Highlanders defeated Fort Bend Dulles in the State Championship, 9-5; and

Whereas, Manager Ron Eastman and his coaching staff led the team to a 38 – 4 record and his third State Championship; and

Whereas, The Woodlands Township issues hearty congratulations to The Woodlands High School Highlanders for being the 2013 Class 5A State Champions in winning its 3rd State Championship; and

Whereas, there is a celebratory parade at Market Street in The Woodlands on June 11 at 6 p.m. to mark and honor The Woodlands High School Highlanders Baseball Team as the reigning 2013 5A Texas State Champions;
