The Development Standards Committee is an architectural design and review group that considers and acts upon requests for variances from property owners as well as considers appeals of decisions made by Residential Design Review Committees. The Committee is also responsible for adopting rules and regulations regarding the administration, interpretation and enforcement of The Woodlands Covenants, Restrictions, Easements, Charges and Liens. The Development Standards Committee typically meets on the first and third Wednesday evenings of every month. The Committee also meets jointly with other committees about four times a year.

The appointees will be required to have experience in architecture, engineering, contracting, building code enforcement or a related field.
