Fall Action Guide now available online

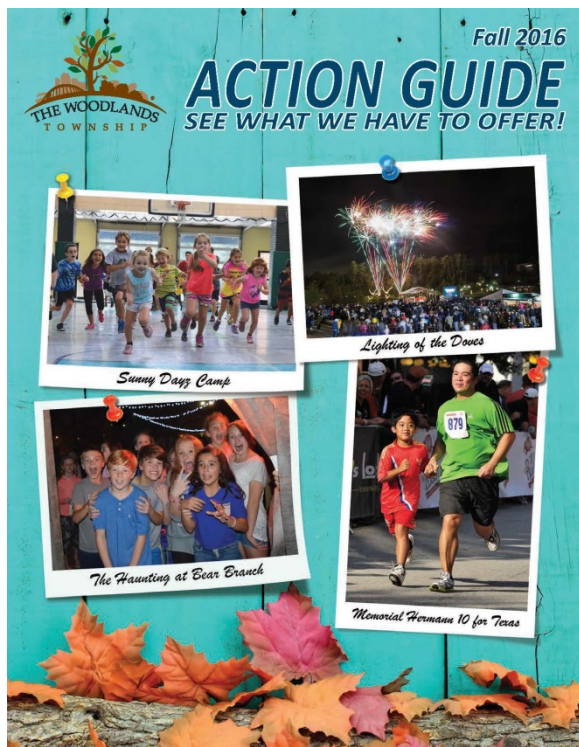
