Township to host seminar on creating habitat for wildlife, pollinators

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (January 14, 2019) – The Woodlands Township will host a free seminar entitled *Creating Habitat in the Garden and Community* on Saturday, February 2, 2019. The event will be held from 8:30 a.m. to 1 p.m. at The Woodlands Emergency Training Center, 16135 I-45 South, Conroe, TX 77385. Space is limited and registration is required.

The seminar will address how various types of wildlife have been impacted by growth in our area, including a session providing a closer look at the monarch butterfly specifically. Additional sessions will suggest ways residents can protect or create habitat, especially for birds and pollinators.
