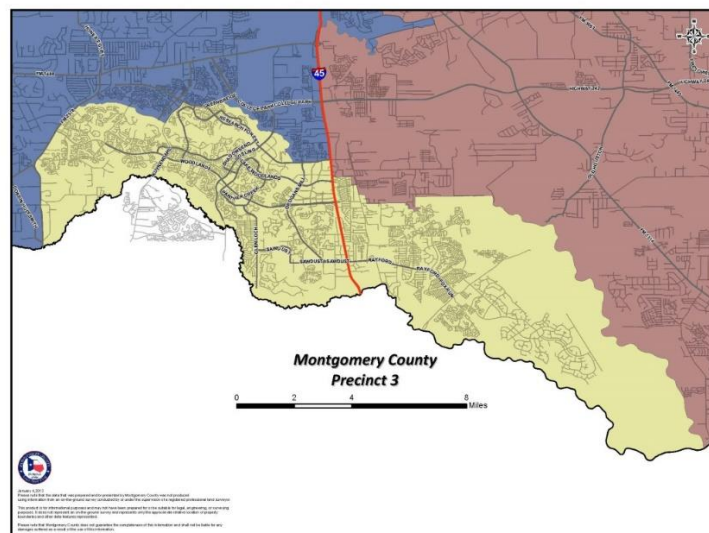

Precinct 3 residents to contact Commissioner's Office directly for service requests

THE WOODLANDS, TEXAS (September 20, 2019) – Montgomery County Precinct 3 has informed The Woodlands Township that residents should now contact the Precinct 3 Commissioner's Office directly for any issues concerning road and street repairs, street signs, traffic lights and other related issues. Although the Township has been forwarding requests to the County on behalf of residents, this will no longer be possible, as per the request of the Montgomery County Precinct 3 office.
