The Development Standards Committee

The Development Standards Committee is an architectural design and review group that considers and acts upon requests for variances from property owners as well as considers appeals of the decisions made by a Residential Design Review Committee.

The Committee is also responsible for adopting rules and regulations regarding the administration, interpretation and enforcement of The Woodlands Covenants, Restrictions, Easements, Charges and Liens and The Residential Development Standards. The Development Standards Committee members meet regularly on the first and third Wednesdays of every month for approximately 3-6 hours. The Committee also meets jointly with other committees about four times a year and may call special meetings 2-6 times a year.

At least two applicants will be required to have experience in architecture, engineering, contracting, building code enforcement or a related field.

Resumes noting training or experience in related fields will also be considered.
